
Working Hours:

Flexible hours based on tipi and furniture hire bookings. Availability to work weekends and bank holidays is an integral part of the job particularly during peak season (April to October).

This is not a typical 9-5 job. Early starts and long days are the norm during peak season (April - October). Remuneration and incentives are available to compensate for such occurrences.

Minimum requirements:
